

## allison munn *and* scott holroyd

The *Carpoolers* star and her beau go back to their roots to tie the knot in South Carolina

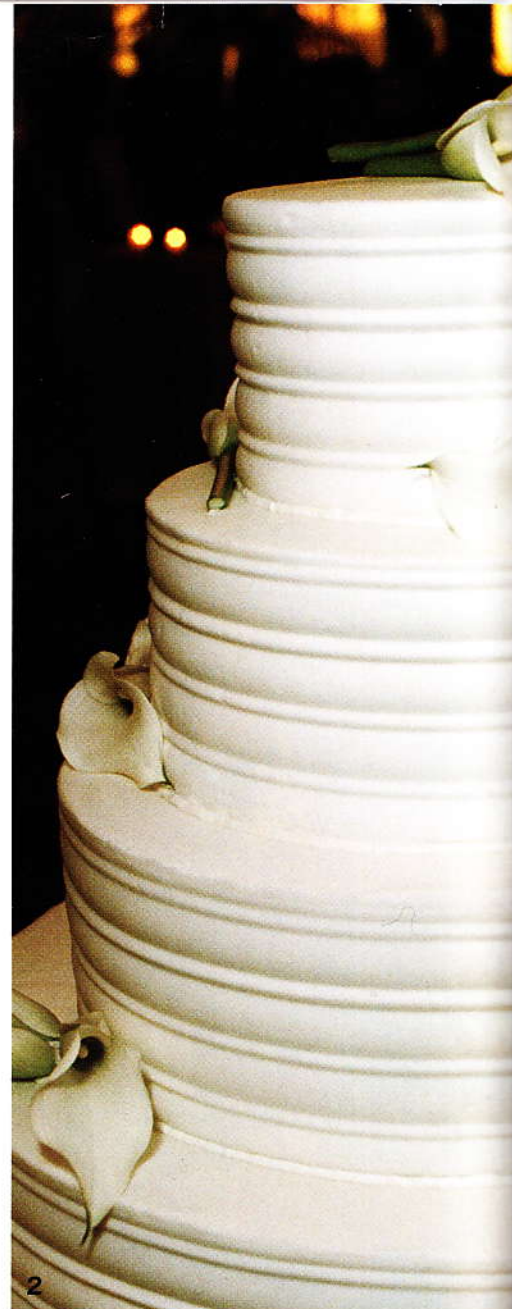
**courtship** Actors Allison Munn, 34, and Scott Holroyd, 33, were high school friends in South Carolina. But it wasn't until they reconnected 2,500 miles and 10 years later while pursuing careers in Los Angeles that the friendship blossomed into something more serious. Six months after their West Coast reunion, Holroyd made his move. "He actually drew a line on the floor with his foot and was like, 'This side is friendship, and this side is a little bit more. I'm about to cross the line,'" Munn recalls.

**proposal** Holroyd's December 2006 proposal at the Eiffel Tower was inspired by an entry in Munn's travel journal during a pre-relationship trip to France. "She wrote, 'Bye, Paris. See you soon—hopefully with the boy I love,'" he says. At the French landmark, Holroyd gave Munn an Asscher-cut diamond in a platinum-and-diamond micro-pavé setting from XIV Karats in Beverly Hills.

**celebration** Less than a year later, on November 17, 2007, the two were married in an evening ceremony at the historic French Huguenot Church in Charleston, S.C. Afterward, guests walked down a luminaria-lined cobblestone street to the reception site, Hibernian Hall, which Munn's aunt, event planner Libby Munn of L Designs, decorated in gold and white.

**menu** To honor their South Carolina upbringing, Munn and Holroyd enlisted local institution Hamby Catering to serve up a selection of traditional Southern grub, such as crab-tomato bisque, ham biscuits, deviled eggs, shrimp and grits, crab cakes and fried green tomatoes. "I wanted our friends who hadn't been to the South to experience the culture," says Munn. —Angela Salazar
